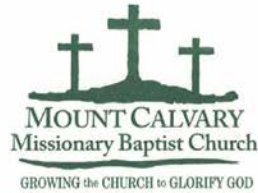

Elijah Prophecy and Prayer

Preparation of prayer Part 1

I King 18: 20 – 29

- A. Mount Carmel: The Lord versus Baal.
 - I. Mount Carmel is close to the Mediterranean south shore, to the plain of Dothan.
 - II. The tribe of Asher border Mount Carmel, it was a good mountain for growing food.
 - III. Elijah said that he was the only prophets of the Lord, although there were other prophets alive at the time (ver. 22), see ver. 13.
 - IV. The contest between the Lord and Baal would reveal who was the true God of storm.
 - V. Sending fire for the wood and the offering would be a reasonable test of the power of the rival deities (ver. 24), see Psalm 18: 12 - 14.
 - VI. The sharp words, for he is a god were mocking and make fun of their god.
 - VII. Perhaps their god was lost , in though, meditating, and simply needed them to call louder.

Conclusion: When we are serving God, in been obedience to Him, it may seem that we are the only one. We must all always remember that God has a Obadiah that is also serving.
